Graduate Student Tinker Field Research Grants Year Two Funding Cycle Now Available

The Latin American and Caribbean Center (LACC) at Florida International University is pleased to announce it has been selected from among the nation's various Latin American Studies programs as a recipient of the prestigious **Tinker Field Research Grant**. The Tinker Grant funds graduate student field research to any Spanish or Portuguese-speaking country in the Caribbean, Latin America, or Iberian Peninsula. LACC received a three-year funding commitment from the Tinker Foundation. The current funding cycle will cover graduate student research travel from January 25 - December 31, 2010. For research-related travel that begins or ends after December 31, 2010, please apply during the 2011 funding cycle. Funding is not available for travel prior to January 25, 2010. Completed applications are due in the LACC office (DM 353) no later than 4:00 pm, Tuesday, December 1, 2009. Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted.
