Julia E. Sweig is the Nelson and David Rockefeller Senior Fellow for Latin American Studies and Director for Latin American Studies at the Council on Foreign Relations. She received her Ph.D. from the Johns Hopkins University School of Advanced International Studies. Her new book *Cuba: What Everyone Needs to Know* provides a guide to Cuba's politics, its complex relationship with the United States, and its changing role in the global community. She has visited the island's prisons, lived with Cuban families following the collapse of the Soviet Union, conducted research in government archives, and interviewed hundreds of Cubans over the last two decades. She is the author of *Inside the Cuban Revolution* (winner of the AHA Herbert Feis award for the best book of the year by an independent scholar) and *Friendly Fire: Losing Friends and Making Enemies in the Anti-American Century*.
