Uva de Aragón, Associate Director of the Cuban Research Institute at Florida International University, holds a Ph.D. in Spanish and Latin American literature from the University of Miami. A narrator, poet, essayist and journalist, she has obtained various literary awards such as the prestigious Beca Cintas. Her works have appeared in anthologies in Spanish as well as in English translations. Some of her recent books are *Memoria del silencio*, *Morir de exilio*, and *Crónicas de la República de Cuba: 1902-1958*.

Mirta Yáñez, a narrator, poet and essayist, received her Ph.D. in Philological Sciences at the Universidad de La Habana in Havana, Cuba. Her numerous literary awards include the *Premio de la Crítica*, bestowed upon her on three separate occasions. Some of her works have been translated into German and English. Her recent publications include *El búfalo ciego y otros cuentos*, *Serafín y las aventuras del Reino de los Comejenes*, *Del azafrán al lirio*, and *Falsos documentos*.
