Rajesh Paulose is the Product Line Manager for Biofuels and Hydrogen in Chevron's Downstream Global Marketing Group. Previously, Mr. Paulose was Program Director of Chevron's Department of Energy Fuel Cell and Hydrogen Infrastructure Validation Program. Since 2006, Mr. Rajesh has helped set the biofuel strategy for Chevron, developing the business case for biofuel, identifying methods of generating liquid fuel from biofeedstocks, and identifying over one hundred biofeedstocks. He is currently looking at producing biofuels using existing petroleum refinery assets. Mr. Paulose holds an MS in Mechanical Engineering from Rice University in Houston and an MBA from the University of Chicago.
