In April 2009, Ambassador Shapiro served as the chargé d'affaires (acting ambassador) at the United States Embassy in Port of Spain, Trinidad and Tobago, where he led preparations for the visit of President Barack Obama to the Fifth Summit of the Americas. In previous assignments, he served as U.S. Ambassador to Venezuela and as Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary for Western Hemisphere Affairs.
